ARTICLE I - NAME

1.1. The LEAGUE shall be known as:

RAINBOW ROCKERS CURLING LEAGUE

ARTICLE II - OFFICERS

- 1.1. The Officers of the Rainbow Rockers Curling League shall be the Past President, President, Secretary, Treasurer, Draw Master, Bonspiel Chair(s), Social Co-ordinator(s), Player Development Co-ordinator, Communications Co-ordinator, Web-Master (technology support), and Membership Co-ordinator. Together, these Officers are also known as the Executive.
- 1.2. There is also one appointed position - Elections Chair.
- 1.3. The Vice-President of the League will be elected from among the elected Executive Members before the end of the first executive meeting. The Vice-President position typically rotates between executive members from year to year. The Vice-President shall represent the President in their absence.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1. Membership is open to all members who are part of a diverse and growing 2SLGBTQIA+ Community.

ARTICLE IV - RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 3.1. Rainbow Rockers League will follow current Curling Canada rules of curling unless otherwise specified and documented on the website.
 - a. All disputes or concerns regarding rules will be settled by the Curling Canada rules and regulations.
 - b. In addition to Curling Canada rules and regulations, the Rainbow Rockers

Curling League has rules listed in Appendix III.

ARTICLE V - BY-LAWS

- 4.1. No alteration shall be made in these By-Laws unless by notice of motion given to the Executive in writing, when the proposed alteration shall be duly vetted by the Executive, entered in the minutes of the Executive Meeting, and voted on by the Membership at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Alterations require a majority vote (50%+1) of those in attendance at the AGM.
- 4.2. The By-Laws will be reviewed annually by the Executive and any suggested changes will be put to the Membership at an AGM.

ARTICLE VI - HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

- 5.1. On the recommendation of the Executive, a person, who is not a regular member of the Rainbow Rockers Curling League, and has contributed to the welfare and support to the League shall be granted an Honorary Life Membership, which entitles the person to all the privileges of a regular Member. If the person desires to play in the league they will be asked to pay the full membership fee.
